School Leadership Series

School leadership is increasingly seen as the key to bringing about large scale reform aimed at improving educational outcomes. This workshop series is intended for administrators who wish to develop a school culture and leadership philosophy which focuses on student learning.

1 Instructional Leadership

Creating change in the learning culture of a school is a challenging task. This session will help principals to unpack their leadership capabilities, understand the breakthrough model, and begin to create their vision and a framework for school change.

2 Accountability and Leadership

In order to be successful it is imperative to embrace systemic accountability and whole school assessment structures. As a leader it is important to understand and embed assessment literacy – collecting and reporting analyzing data – in the school culture. This session will focus on creating systems of accountability.

3 Capability for Data Driven Instruction

Intervention, monitoring and providing support are key to student achievement. Learning to lead with organizational capability for maximizing student outcomes by aligning data to instruction is the focus of this session.

4 Providing Feedback

Ensure appropriate intervention and assistance for all students by understanding, observing, and providing feedback to teaching staff on differentiation and instruction. This session focuses on monitoring teacher success in the classroom and building teacher capacity to support learning.

5 Building a Professional Learning Community

The successful leader understands that building a community of learners is essential to bringing about sustainable change. This session focuses on building Professional Learning Communities to support teacher professional development, build capacity and support your strategic plan for whole school change.

6 Monitoring and Reflecting for Forward Planning

The final session is designed to review and reflect on the entire series. Participants will have monitored their progress along the way in order to reflect on both individual leadership and school goals for forward planning.
